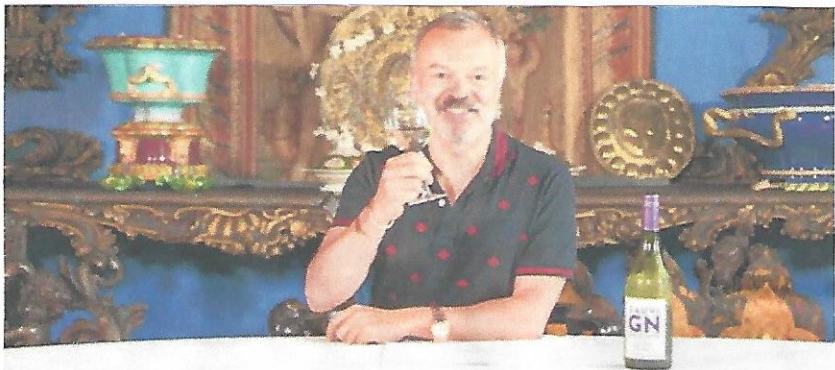


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New Zealand's favourite chat show host Graham Norton is back with a bang—and a bottle—with a cheeky new vintage for 2016. The famed talk show host's 2015 blend sold out in Ireland, the UK, Australia and New Zealand last year. Last month talk show host Graham Norton and Kiwi winemakers Invivo (cofounder Tim Lightbourne and winemaker Rob Cameron) headed to Graham's own backyard to work their winemaking magic: Bantry House in County Cork, Ireland. Then, over a reportedly riotous afternoon blending session the trio created Graham's 2016 Sauvignon Blanc and new for 2016 a Graham Norton Shiraz. According to wineorbit.co.nz, it's a five-star wine "filled with gorgeous passionfruit, nectarine, feijoa and lime zest flavours". "It is fragrant and intense, and delivers loads of tasty flavours backed by juicy acidity. A hugely appealing Sauvignon with varietal purity and power [that] finishes superbly long and refreshing."
