It is now going great guns and

supplying to 13 countries, where it can be found in exclusive retail outlets such as Harvey Nichols and the 5-star Glen Eagles Scottish resort.

Lightbourne would not give its marketing secrets away in regards to Peaches, but it is not the first time it has appeared on the English celebrity circuit. It is also the official wine supplier for the *Graham Norton Show*.

Every high-profile guest appearing on the show receives an Invivo bottle in a gift bag. Over the pond in New York, ex-*America's Top Model* judge **Nigel Barker** is also an Invivo ambassador.
