Cheeky little number with rampant fruit

FIRM'S GRAHAM NORTON WINE

BOOZY BBC host Graham Norton is having a brand of WINE launched under his name.

The firm, which has supplied his chat show with vino for the past two years, is creating a special Graham Norton sauvignon blanc in honour of its best customer.

New Zealand company Invivo Wines has been planning the move and is now ready to put the Norton plonk into production.

It will initially create a 500-bottle run. If it is a success, it will be rolled out into the market.

Tim Lightbourne, of Invivo, which has provided Irishman Graham with a case of wine every week for the past two years, said: "It's something we have been working on for some while."

"We would make a special sauvignon blanc, single vineyard with some oak."

"We've supplied the show for a couple of years now. Graham has our sauvignon and every one of his special guests receives a bottle to take home - plus our wines are in the green room."

Mark Wahlberg famously enjoyed the arrangement in February when he appeared sloshed on the sofa.

Tim continued: "It's pretty good for us as not only is Graham drinking the wine, but also the likes of some pretty heavy-hitter global celebrities."

"It is also a talking point for us - it's to show our customers that we're trying to do things to be talked about -



getting the wine in the right hands." The firm started its relationship with Graham after Tim read about his love of New World tipples.

Tim said he was keen to work with the producers of the show, which has run for 13 series.

He said: "We initially approached the production team after I read he was a fan of New Zealand wine."

"After sending Graham the wine, we had feedback that he really liked our sauvignon blanc so we discussed supplying it for the show."

"Basically, I wanted to be the official wine of the show, which they've allowed me."

"Every week during filming we supply enough bottles for Graham and his guests."

Favourite

This year the owners of the Kiwi firm were invited to the UK to meet Graham and have a chat about their booze which they say has now become his favourite.

News about the firm's plans for putting Graham on the label comes weeks after the star's former lover Trevor Patterson claimed the flamboyant chat show host would often down up to four bottles of wine a night during their two-year relationship.

Patterson claimed: "He could drink up to four bottles of wine in an evening."

"He loves to drink and it's usually sauvignon blanc, champagne and vodka and tonic."

"Even if we stayed home, he would have some wine. He told me he liked to have a glass before the show to help take the edge off."
