*Orbitali Primitivo 2014,  
£5, Asda*

FROM the heel of Italy, this pleasingly rustic red made from the Primitivo grape has earthy bramble fruit flavours, a dash of spice, and an unpolished quality that totally works. A serious bargain, so fill your boots.

### RED

*Monteflores Malbec 2014,  
£10, M&S*

THIS Fairtrade red is a properly great Malbec from Argentina. With layers of fleshy plum and blackberry flavours, it also has lovely toasty notes due to time spent in French oak barrels. At 14.5 per cent, this really does need food – or a nearby sofa, at least.

**Food pairing:** Roast lamb.

### WHITE

*Graham Norton's Own  
Sauvignon Blanc 2016,  
£10.99 (£8.99 if you  
mix six), Majestic*

IT'S the second year, Norton's blended his own wine with New Zealand producer Invivo. Last year, it sold more than 400,000 bottles! If you love your Sauvignon with ripe, tropical fruit flavours and lots of zing, this is just the thing.

**Food pairing:** Salty crisps.

### ROSE

*Chateau Tour de  
Mirambeau 2015,  
£10.60, Tanners*

PROVENCE rose might be the headline act, but other areas make great rose, too. From Bordeaux, this is made of Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, with soft strawberry fruit flavours; fabulously fresh, too.

**Food pairing:** Antipasti.
