

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), Invivo & Co Limited is authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises situated at 55 Te Kauwhata Road Te Kauwhata and known as <https://invivowines.com/>

Endorsement

Section 40 of the Act applies to this licence; and the licensee is authorised to sell alcohol from (but not on) the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

- (a) No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day, Easter Sunday, or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) Alcohol may be delivered under the licence only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 6.00am to 11.00pm
- (c) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - (i) Display appropriate information at every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons;
 - (ii) Request age declaration from all customers before orders are placed and after sale is completed in accordance with Regulation 14 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013.
- (d) The following information must be displayed on the internet site in a prominent place, in any catalogue used by the licence holder and on every receipt issued for any alcohol sold via the internet site:
 - (i) The licence holder's name, the licence number and the date on which the licence expires.
- (e) The licensee must take the following steps to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises are observed:
 - (i) All staff will be trained in their responsibilities under the Act.
- (f) The sale or delivery of alcohol is authorised from the premises generally. The premises situated at 55 Te Kauwhata Road Te Kauwhata are more precisely identified in a plan date stamped as received by the Waikato District Licensing Committee on 4 March 2020.
- (g) The licence shall be endorsed under s40 of the Act.

Display of Licence

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Te Kauwhata Road is designated as the principal entrance.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force-

- (a) until its expiry date detailed below; OR
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.
