

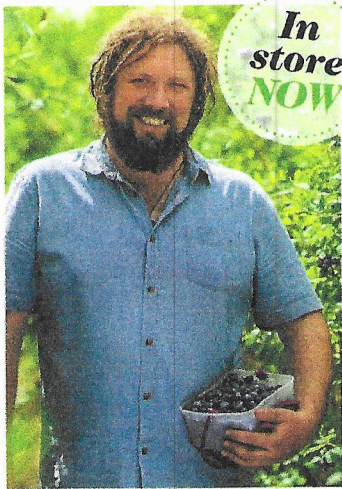

Berry nice

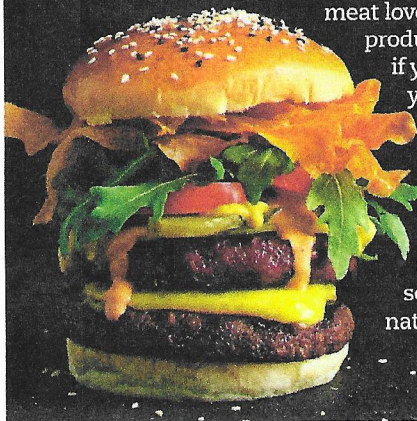

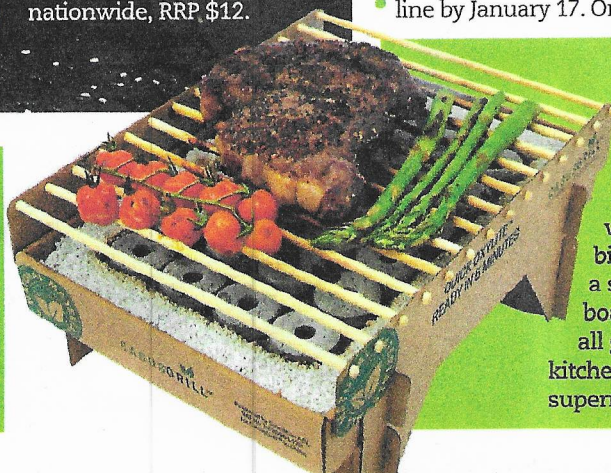
